- Select and clean historical data to train anomaly detection models, removing noise and shutdown states.
- Deploy anomaly detection models to identify deviations in asset behavior.
- Implement persistence criteria to reduce false alarms and ensure meaningful anomaly detection.
- Generate and classify anomaly events based on severity and rate of change.
- Identify machine operating modes using predefined tags to enhance contextual analysis.
